



The Lighthouse Child & Family Development Center (LCFDC) is a faith-based family development program for low-income families with children 0-5. The project of the Musgrave Foundation assists families in becoming more informed, competent, and self-sufficient members of the Springfield community through intensive case management, parent education, community involvement, and the provision of a nurturing childcare environment. All of these services are currently offered to participating families at no cost in exchange for their active program participation and demonstrated progress toward self-sufficiency.

If you meet all of the following criteria, you may be eligible to receive services from the LCFDC:

IN NEED OF CARE

All adults in household are full-time employed or full-time student
One or more child age 0-5 in need of daytime care

LOW-INCOME HOUSEHOLD

Total household earning less than:
\$1485/month in a 2-person household
\$1835/month in a 3-person household
\$2185/month in a 4-person household
\$2500/month in a 5-person household
\$2885/month in a 6-person household

MOTIVATED

Family wants to become self-sufficient and decrease the need for public assistance
Willing to attend monthly family education classes
Willing to volunteer 15 hours/year at the Lighthouse

COMMITTED

Committed to improving their family situation
Willing to establish self-improvement goals and work toward achievement
Can demonstrate commitment to employment, education, family, and faith
